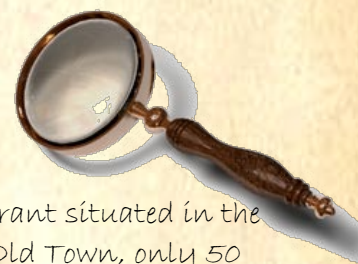
About Us
